




From the Top Down

To borrow a title, the Brave New [Automotive] World includes a variety of electronics on your car. Here is a tale about what such features could mean.



He drives a high-performance German sedan. The day after his return home, he walked up to his car, which is supposed to recognize the approaching key fob, and unlock. Nothing. Push the unlock button. Nothing. There is an emergency key in the fob, so he was able to open the door and attempt to re-connect the fob to the car. Nothing.

Now what? The battery has gone flat, there is no key-operated ignition switch, and everything is electric. There are jump-start terminals under the hood. The battery itself is in the trunk, under the floor, under the spare, under components of the air suspension system. Probably shouldn't jump start without at least putting eyes on the battery. In fact, it's probably easier to just purchase a new one. Can't open the trunk without electricity.

Try to enter the trunk by folding down the rear seat. Thanks to where he parked, the rear door on the driver's side is too close to a pillar. It can't be opened. Reach over and manually unlock the passenger doors. Cannot fold the rear seat on the passenger side all the way down because the front seat is too far back. Slide over, fold down the driver's side rear seat, shimmy through the opening, locate and pull the emergency inside trunk release. Whew! The trunk is open.

Must match the exact specs to replace the battery: voltage, cold cranking amps, amp hour capacity, and, most important of all, the physical dimensions to fit a very tight spot. Result: none of the chain auto parts stores have batteries that match. The dealer will have to replace the battery. But the car is not drivable. Bought a trickle charger. The only reachable outlet in the parking garage turns out to be dead. Bought a portable jump starter. Hallelujah!

The replacement battery from the dealer was \$800, the price of high performance German engineering.

Two lessons: 1. Today's many electronic features mean that something is always drawing current. If you will be away for more than two weeks, connect a trickle charger. 2. There are portable jump starters that fit easily in the glove box and start at around \$100. Every member of the Utah Miata Club might want to have one in their emergency kit. Be sure to spec it correctly.

35th Anniversary MX-5 Miata by Mike Bailey

I went to the Salt Lake New Car Auto Expo at the Mountain America Expo Center a few weeks ago. I was interested in seeing how much new cars have risen in price since I purchased my two new SUV's a year and a half ago. Lynn really loves her Mazda CX-5. Mazda makes such good cars! The 35th Anniversary Miata is supposed to be coming out sometime this year but a date has not yet been announced. I was able to talk with a Mazda rep at the car show and they couldn't give me a date on this. I also talked to Lindsey Lawrence, a sales rep from Bountiful Mazda at the show and previously



last month to MJ McDonald while I was visiting Bountiful Mazda. Both MJ and Lindsey did not have much information except about the color and interior. **The special edition color will be Artisan Red Metallic with Light Tan Nappa Leather Interior and Seats.** The 35th AE logo will be on the headrests and 35 AE Badges on the rear fenders and include a back rear spoiler in same color. This Special Edition is fully loaded and has every additional addons. It also has unique special wheels, with upgraded brakes and a revised suspension.













The 35th AE will also have the same 181 HP 2.0 liter 4 cylinder engine. Articles on it state that they may only come with a 6-

speed and no automatics will be available. I'm not sure if this is true or just auto magazine talk! Price is listed at \$37,435.00. Talk is that they may only allocate 300 to the USA. A special model of the 35th AE will also be given to owners. Will keep you posted on this but if you want one contact Bountiful Mazda and get on a list to order one!



Another 2025 Special Edition Aero Spirit Racing Roadster will be coming out with an Aero Grey Paint scheme and will have all the upgrades, bells and whistles and have supposedly 197 HP.

Roadtrippin' After Memorial Day 2025 - by Roger Heath

When: Friday, May 30, 2025—Sunday, June 1, 2025

Two night, 3 day roadtrip after Memorial Day weekend, May 30th - June 1st, 2025, traveling through the red rock area in southeastern Utah. After meeting up at the Harmon's Bangerter Crossing store in Draper we'll head out on Hwy 6 to Price, Utah. From Price we'll turn south on Hwy 10 until we reach I-70. We'll drive under the freeway and join Hwy 72 into Loa, finally stopping in Torrey for the night.



Day 2 we head to Hanksville and through Hite then up to Blanding, Moab before stopping in Green River for the night. Day 3: Coming home on Sunday there are various routes you can take, quickest is Hwy 6 back to Spanish Fork. Or, I-70 to Salina then north to Nephi and I-15. Another possibility is Hwy 6 to Price, then over to Duchesne towards Beaver or Kamas and home.

May 30th: Meet at the Harmon's Bangerter Crossing store, 125 13800 S, Draper, at 9:00 AM and travel to Torrey. (220 miles)

May 31st: Drive from Torrey to Green River (298 Miles). June 1st: Drive home after breakfast. Maybe over to Huntington or Farview Canyons or alternate routes around the area.






